Early Admission General Information

The University of South Florida offers academically talented high school students the opportunity to enter the University as full-time, degree-seeking students prior to their graduation from high school (public, private, or home school). Current research shows that those Early Admission students who are successful at USF present academic credentials well above the minimum requirements for admission. Early Admission candidates are admitted after a review of the high school transcript, SAT and ACT scores, the applicant's personal letter, and the high school recommendation. After acceptance, the Early Admission student is informed of academic advising services available. The student's school board and/or high school principal may grant high school graduation credit for courses taken at USF.

Students wishing to be accepted as Early Admission students at USF **must**:

- Have completed the equivalent of the junior year of high school (a minimum of six semesters of full-time secondary enrollment, including studies undertaken in the ninth grade), thus requiring only one additional year to complete requirements for the high school diploma;
- Submit a completed Application for Undergraduate Admission and \$30 non-refundable application fee
- Have proof of a 1200 on the SAT II (Q & V), with no less than 440 on SAT II Verbal and 440 on SAT II Quantitative; or a 27 on the ACT, with no less than a score of 16 on ACT English and ACT Reading and a score of 18 on ACT Mathematics, and a 3.5 high school grade point average (computed by USF) and a TOEFL score of 550, if applicable
- Must meet regular USF admission criteria for degree-seeking undergraduate students
- Submit a personal letter outlining reasons for seeking early admission
- Submit completed Supplemental Information for Early Admission Form
- Home school students must submit an official copy of their Letter of Intent with their home school district
- Private school students must submit proof that their school is a SACS accredited school
- **Statement of Legal Compliance** and/or **Copy of SACS Accreditation** (to be completed by private high schools or home school parent).
- Must notify the Coordinator of Early Admission of progress and the desire to continue at the end of each semester.

After receipt of the above documents and student's high school transcript and SAT or ACT scores, the University will mail to the applicant information about a personal interview, if necessary.
